Clubhouse – We are currently still awaiting notification from the Welsh Assembly Government and Sport Wales regarding our grant application. The architect is pressing on with producing working drawings which should be ready by mid to late October. It is anticipated that a planned start date at the beginning of November will go ahead. Slipway – Representatives from the Club have had another site meeting with the Leisure Services, Tourism Dept, Engineer and the Planners of Conwy CBC. Progress is still being made towards the construction of a concrete slipway opposite Venue Cymru which is to be twice the width of the present wooden slipway.

Dinghy Park

Due to the forth-coming extension work on the Clubhouse, members are required to remove their boats and trailers from the boat-park by **31st October 2010**. It is necessary for the boat-park to be completely emptied to allow the gravel and soil dug out at the front of the club to be deposited usefully, thus we intend to use it to level out and tidy up the surface of the park. Every effort will be made by the club to assist those without road trailers, although this cannot be guaranteed.

It is anticipated that boats may be returned to the boat-park in time for the Boxing Day race, by which time berths will have been allocated and re-issued on the basis of the number of times that members have sailed during this last season. Double-handers will be allocated berths on one side and single-handers on the other.

The Management Committee apologize for this disruption but hope that the new front extension and tidier boat-park can only enhance membership of the Sailing Club.
